A summer day camp for children ages 4-12

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of Camp Accokeek is to provide the community with responsible child supervision through constructive, kid-centered activities in a structured but relaxed environment. Camp Accokeek, as a mission of Christ Church, believes that the best environment for all is one in which mutual respect is given and received.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Camp Accokeek always expects respect to be shown: respect for counselors, teachers, peers, and the facilities. If a child displays disrespectful behavior, the parents will be notified. If this behavior continues, the Rector and Vestry of Christ Church will also be notified. A pattern of unchanging, disrespectful behavior will result in the immediate removal of a child from Camp Accokeek. By enrolling your child or children in Camp Accokeek, you are acknowledging this code of conduct and agreeing to its terms.

CAMP HOURS

7:00 AM to 6:00 AM, June 17 to August 17 (nine weekly sessions)

Children must be signed in and signed out daily on the attendance sheet. If you plan to have your child picked up by someone else, please send a written notification with the person's name and relationship to your child.

If a child is not picked up by 6:00pm, the charge is \$1.00 per minute per child.

TUITION INFORMATION

Weekly rate: **\$225** first child **\$200** for each additional child per family (Discount available for members of Christ Church Accokeek)

Weekly payments are due every Monday and may be made by PayPal, Zelle or Check. Checks should be made payable to "Camp Accokeek"

Week 3 is the only week allowed to be prorated (due to the July 4 holiday). If your child is absent a day or two during a weekly session, full payment is still expected to be paid to Camp Accokeek.

FIELD TRIPS

Field Trips are scheduled once a week, usually on Thursdays. All field trip fees are included in the cost of tuition.

SUPPLIES

Each child should have the following items daily. *Please label their names in permanent ink.*

- Bathing Suit and Towel
- Sunscreen (please sign an authorization form)
- Lunch and afternoon snack
- Water bottle (can refill bottle at the water fountain)
- Appropriate shoes for hiking in the woods and playing outdoors. (Campers cannot wear flip-flops or other strapless shoes for sports. They must have shoes that strap on to their feet to prevent injury.)

Scooters and skateboards are permitted at Camp, at campers' own risk. A protective helmet must be worn.

Electronics are only permitted during arrival/quiet play and departure/quiet time.

Electronics are not permitted at the pool. Camp Accokeek is not responsible for lost or broken items.

All phones and electronics must be kept in campers' bookbags during activities.

LUNCH/SNACK

Campers are required to bring lunch every day. A refrigerator for storing lunches is available as needed. Please prepare a nutritious lunch for your child with a drink in a non-glass container. A microwave is available for heating food. The camp will provide a healthy morning snack. Please include an afternoon snack.

SWIMMING

Camp Accokeek will be going to the Moyaone pool every day, weather permitting. Fees are \$5 per day, payable by Friday. All campers who are enrolled for more than 3 weeks must obtain a pool membership. Moyaone Pool Association offers a discounted price of \$100 per child for the swim season.

Campers must pass a swim test, administered by the lifeguards on duty, to be allowed to swim in the deep end of the pool. All others must swim in the shallow end.

If a camper has passed the swim test, it is still at the discretion of the parents to allow the child to swim in the deep end. Younger campers do well with swim vests. Water shoes are allowed in the pool.

Your child/children may want to arrive at camp already dressed for swimming.

MEDICATIONS

In order for Camp Accokeek to administer prescribed <u>and</u> over-the-counter medications, a Medical Authorization Form must be completed and signed by a doctor. Please make sure the doctor signs both boxes because approval is needed for the camper to self carry and self administer medications. Campers are only allowed to carry emergency medications.
